



## NETWORK UPDATE JANUARY 2012

Positive news.

In this latest edition you'll find a wider range of NZI line posts, our new range of AX spindles and clevis thimbles, DTR polymer insulators, a range of Avon line hardware and a deeper offering of Bussmann fuselinks. You won't find parallel-imported or brown-glazed porcelain – they're being phased out.



NZI is opening a new warehouse in West Auckland and gradually we'll be making North Island deliveries out of the Auckland warehouse.



From 1st Feb we'll be operating from 11 Wookey Lane in Kumeu, which thanks to the motorway extension is now just 16 minutes (23km) from CBD Auckland. The new NZI Auckland phone number is 09-412 5941.
